Sec. 19-127. Phase III mandatory water conservation.

Phase III mandatory water conservation restrictions and rules are in effect for Foxfire Village's water customers as follows:

- (1) *Outdoor water uses:*
 - a. Irrigation uses of the village public water supply are prohibited as follows:
 - 1. Automatic spray irrigation and non-automatic spray irrigation is prohibited.
 - 2. Hose-end sprinkler is prohibited.
 - 3. Hand-held hose watering devices is prohibited.
 - 4. Low volume drip irrigation is prohibited.
 - 5. New landscape establishment permits will not be issued.
 - b. Filling new swimming or wading pools is prohibited. Filling of pools drained for repair after the effective date of Phase III mandatory restrictions and rules is prohibited. Potable water may be added to pools to maintain sanitary operating conditions.
 - c. Residents are prohibited from vehicle washing activities.
 - d. Residents are prohibited from washing areas such as sidewalks, patios, decks, driveways, parking lots, streets and exterior building surfaces. This restriction shall not apply to the washing of soiled areas for maintenance of public health and sanitary conditions. The commercial use of power washer is permitted.
 - e. Leaking water services or plumbing must be repaired within 24 hours of written notification by the water department.
- (2) Indoor water uses:
 - a. Drinking water shall not be served in a public restaurant, except upon request.
 - b. Hotels/motels/bed and breakfast inns will ask guests spending more than one night to use their towels and bed linens more than once between laundering.
 - c. Commercial and industrial customers shall review their water uses and implement industry specific best management water conservation practices.
