

Changing from .com to a .gov domain

Hi Lisa,

I did have a thought about your website security question. You might consider registering a .gov domain name. The federal government strongly recommends making the switch for security and general recognition. The process is pretty simple and we're happy to help!

.gov domains are administered by the federal government and only official government agencies are allowed to register them. Upgrading to foxfirenc.gov or something similar would distinguish your website as the official village website.

- You can sign up for your domain at <https://get.gov/>
- There is no cost for the domain registration.
- We charge \$350 per year for the security certificate and .gov DNS hosting.
