Hello Mayor Gregorich,

Thank you for taking the time to read through this community event information and your willingness to speak with me about a specific request.

I've started to coordinate a service project for June 6th, 9:30-11:00 am. I've connected with the EIF, and they are aware and supportive.

- I volunteer with [Sleep in Heavenly Peace – Sandhills Chapter](#), a nonprofit organization whose mission is that "no kid sleeps on the floor in our town" and want to host a Community Bed Build on Saturday, June 6, 2026, from 9:00-11:30am, in Foxfire. During this event, community volunteers would work together to build beds that will be delivered at a later time to local children and teens in need. All materials for the bed build are provided through sponsors and donors, so there is no cost for lumber or hardware.
- Prior to the Community Bed Build, I'll coordinate volunteer sign up via online form and a Bedding Drive to collect new twin-size "Bed in a Bag" sets so each child receives a complete bed. The goal is to collect approximately 30-40 sets, with donation drop-off locations proposed at Village Hall, Foxfire Golf Club, Fox Brew Coffee Shop, or through an online Amazon wish list.
- This event offers a meaningful opportunity to bring our community together in service, support children in need, and showcase Foxfire's commitment to helping others.

In addition to any feedback or advice you have regarding this event or community service, I have a request.

The SHP-Sandhills Chapter president, Tom Bourne, and I have surveyed a few locations to host the bed build. We've looked at the parking lot of Fox Brew, Village Green Park, Foxfire Golf Course parking lot...and the parking lot at Village Hall.

Tom believes the parking lot at Village Hall is ideal, for a few reasons including logistics, safety, resources (primarily aa power outlet) and noise (hand sanders and saws).

I realize this might be an unconventional request and it will require approval not only from you (possibly the board), but also the Police and Fire Departments. I also expect there will be requirements related to liability insurance or fees to consider (similar to Village Green Park).

I appreciate the opportunity to meet and speak about the event and possible logistics.

## Bedding Drive (Community Donation Component)

While there is **no cost for bed materials** (all lumber and hardware are provided by SHP sponsors and donors), Sleep in Heavenly Peace requests that each bed be paired with **new bedding**.

Goal: Collect 30–40 twin-size "Bed in a Bag" sets (sheets, pillowcases, comforter) for children and teens. "Bed in a Bag" sets are available on Amazon at a starting around \$25 each, which many consider as a reasonable to donate an item.
